

terms.



Literacy



In Room 4, we have been learning about the purpose of persuasive texts and how to write them. This includes analysing a variety of persuasives and students creating their own rhetorical questions.

Our spelling program, Spelling Mastery, has started with students working at their level and across the Thirarndi classrooms.

Mrs Bell is teaching the class how to use rulers, tape measures, trundle wheels and more to measure different objects. Students are also converting measurements into millimetres, centimetres and metres.

HASS

Learning about how the past has influenced the present is very important. In HASS, we are looking at why the Europeans came to Australia and how it impacted the local Aboriginal people. Did you know that the First Fleet took 252 days to reach Australia and sailed 24,000 kms?


Our students have also been learning how to read and write persuasive texts. Our Year 6's put these skills to good use when writing and presenting their leaderships speeches.

Science

Mrs Agnew

We have had a busy start to the year in the Science Room. We are studying Chemical Sciences, which always involves lots of smelling, mixing and examining of materials!

Our junior primary students have been learning about everyday materials and how we can change them physically. We have moulded playdough, melted chocolate and stretched detergent (bubbles!), rubber (balloons!) and lolly snakes (Yum!)















Our middle primary classes are learning that adding or removing heat can create a change of state between liquid and solid. We have examined a range of different solids and liquids to determine their different properties and tried to match some materials which had been melted and reset with their original states.

Our senior students are learning about the three states of matter (solids, liquids and gases) and how the molecules in each state behave. They are looking at the observable properties of matter and how each state of matter behaves. We have classified, poured, shook and sniffed different materials and tested liquids for their viscosity!









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
Wajarri Miss Tash


